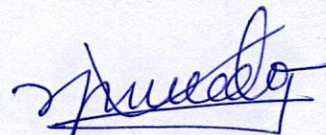

Report on Seminar held on Life Skill – Yoga Practice

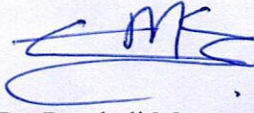

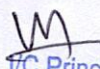
Report on Language and Communication Skills – Read Aloud

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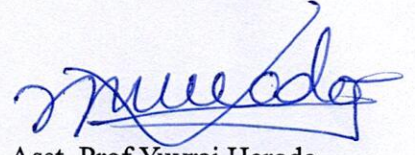




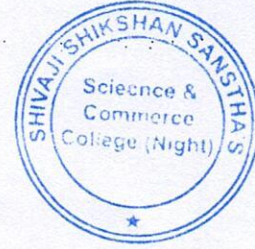

Report on session: Career Guidance conducted on 17th September 2022

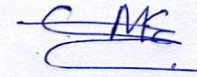

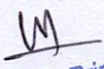
Report on an online workshop "Career Aspects in Different Fields"

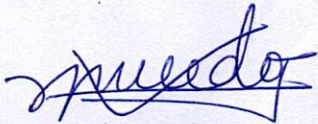

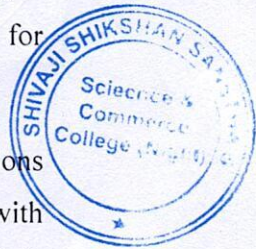

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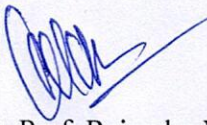
Report on Soft Skills – Tally and Accounts

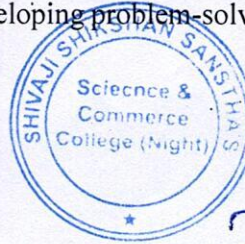

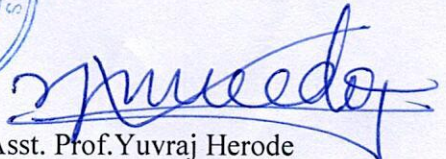

Report on Seminar held on Life Skill – The Value of Yoga in Life.

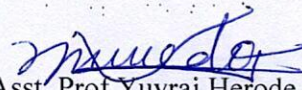

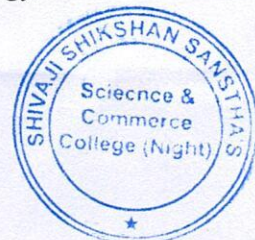
Report on ICT/Computing Skills - Shifts in Indian Economic Policy

The session emphasized the importance of ICT skills in navigating and benefiting from significant shifts in Indian economic policy. Understanding these changes and having the necessary ICT skills are crucial for individuals and businesses to adapt, stay competitive, and capitalize on new opportunities in the evolving economic landscape of India.

Mr. Pathre highlighted key shifts in Indian economic policy, starting with the 1991 economic reforms that reduced government control, promoted private sector growth, and encouraged foreign investment. The Start-up India Initiative (2016) supported innovation and entrepreneurship, leading to a growth of tech-based start-ups where ICT skills are vital. The GST implementation (2017) simplified the tax system, necessitating ICT skills for efficient tax management. The Atmanirbhar Bharat (Self-Reliant India) initiative (2020) aimed to promote self-sufficiency and local production, where ICT skills are key for developing local technologies. Additionally, the focus on renewable energy and sustainability has driven the growth of green technology, requiring ICT skills for managing sustainable solutions.

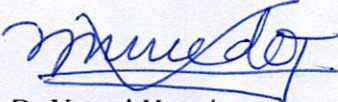
Report on Seminar held on Skill Enhancement – GST.

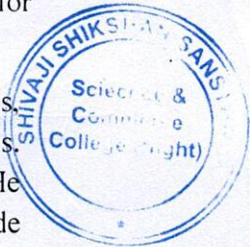
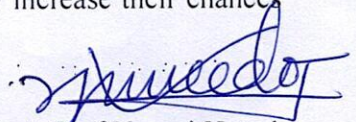

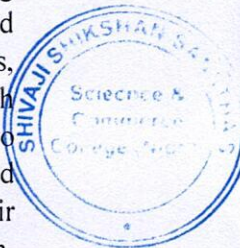

On 5th November 2020, Dr. Sushil Joshi conducted an online Zoom session from 7 pm to 8 pm titled "Life Skill - Researching the Health Effects of Chemicals." The primary purpose of this session was to equip participants with the skills needed to effectively research the health effects of chemicals using online resources. Dr. Joshi emphasized the importance of understanding the health impacts of chemicals to make informed decisions about personal health, safety, and environmental practices.

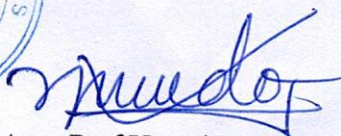
Key steps covered in the session included identifying the exact chemical name, including synonyms, and using reliable sources such as government and international health organizations (CDC, EPA, WHO, NIH), educational institutions, and scientific databases like PubMed and Google Scholar. Evaluating the credibility of sources was also highlighted, with a focus on checking author credentials, publication dates, avoiding biased sources, and preferring peer-reviewed articles.

Participants were taught to understand both the short-term and long-term health effects of chemicals by considering dosage, exposure levels, study context, and the populations studied. Additionally, Dr. Joshi advised checking regulatory information for guidelines and permissible exposure limits from agencies like the EPA, FDA, and OSHA. This comprehensive approach ensures thorough and accurate research, enabling better-informed decisions regarding chemical exposure and health.

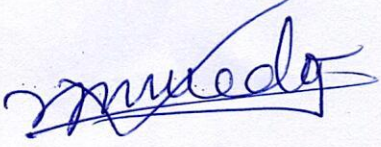

Ms. Nare advised testing the slogan's effectiveness by gathering feedback from a sample audience and refining it as needed. She also recommended utilizing online tools such as slogan generators and researching successful examples to enhance creativity and effectiveness in slogan design.


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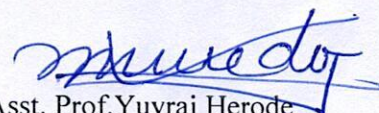

Report on A Competitive Exam Mind-set: Student Work Ethics

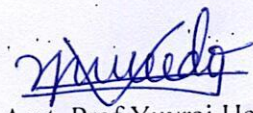
